This event is open to all motorsport and car enthusiasts and will take the form of a daytime Tour starting late morning and finishing around 4pm. This event will circumnavigate the River Tay, starting and finishing at Broxden Services, Perth taking in rally routes from the 1960's. The organising team look forward to meeting old friends and newcomers alike.

REGULATIONS

- Ecosse Rallye Drivers Club will promote a touring assembly on Sunday 31 October 2021 under a Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption for a Touring Assembly. Permit number 334596 has been obtained.
- 2 The event is open to all car enthusiasts.
- The event will start and finish at Broxden Services, Perth. PH2 OPX with the first car leaving at 11.00.
- 4 Signing On will take place from 10.00 at the Park and Ride car park, Broxden Services, Perth PH2 OPX. Cars will start at one-minute intervals from 11am.
 - Entrants will be required to sign a declaration stating they have the following where required by law.

A valid MOT Certificate

Vehicle Excise Duty paid

A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

The route will be on public A and B Class and unclassified roads which will all be on sealed surfaces. Details of the route will be sent out by email prior to the event in the form of a Tulip Roadbook which can be downloaded and printed.



The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form, closing on Sunday 24 October 2021. Cars may only carry the number of passengers permitted by the seating accommodation.

This event is free. You will receive a rally plate and identification numbers. The roadbook will be sent out by email before the event. and other necessary documents.

Food will be available at the Service Station, McDonalds and the Broxden Manor restaurant.
