## Deeside Tour 26 July 2008

### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The Deeside Tour starts at 10:00am on 26<sup>th</sup> July from Aberdeen. The event will take crews on a trip round Royal Deeside, through some of Scotland's finest scenery, with time to stop and visit some of the many locations the route will pass. The event is open to historic, post historic, classic and modern sporting cars. In keeping with CCHMSC's touring events you are invited to dress in the appropriate style for the year of manufacture of your car. A prize will be awarded to the best crew. The organisers look forward to receiving your entry.

#### 1. **Announcement:**

The Caledonian Classic and Historic Motorsport Club Ltd will promote the Classic AutoSports sponsored Deeside Tour starting from Aberdeen on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2008. A map of the start venue will be issued with the final instructions.

#### 2. **Jurisdiction:**

The event will be held under the general rules of the MSA as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. An MSA Touring Assembly Permit has been granted, Permit No TBA.

#### 3. **Eligibility:**

The event is open to all members of the Caledonian Classic and Historic Motor Sport Club Ltd. Membership may be added to the entry form if required (£5 per person)

#### 4. **Vehicles:**

The event is open to the following:

- a) Cars manufactured before 1980.
  - b) Sporting cars of any age.
  - c) Kit cars.
  - d) Other cars permitted at the discretion of the organisers.
- Cars constructed before 1980 will be given preference for entry.  
No motorbike or combinations will be permitted to enter the event.

#### 5. **Entry List:**

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form.  
The entry list closes on 18th July 2008.  
Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.

#### 6. **Documentation:**

Pre event document inspection and signing on will take place from 8.30am. First car will depart at 10.00am. The start location will be provided in the Final instructions, along with your start time.

**7. Scrutineering:**

Owners of the entered vehicles will be asked to sign a declaration that their vehicle has current and valid Road Fund Licence, a minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles, and a valid MOT certificate for the duration of the event. Cars must comply with the MSA regulations for the event.

**8. Route, Navigation and Driving Behaviour:**

The route will be about 130 miles in total, on public A and B class and unclassified roads. The route will be on sealed surfaces. The route will be defined by tulip diagrams which will be supplied after inspection of documentation and signing on prior to the start. A sample will be sent out with the final instructions.

**Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Please remember other road users, cyclists, walkers and livestock.**

**9. Entries:**

The entry fee is £34. This includes the Roadbook, a decal to display on the vehicle, and meals for two crew members at the finish. All entries must be made on the entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Maximum number of entries is 40. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. **No email entries will be accepted. All entries must be on the official entry form, with the appropriate fee enclosed.**

**12. Controls:**

Route checks may be in place to establish that the correct route has been adhered to.

**13. Awards:**

1. The Oldest Car to complete the route.
2. Car of the event as voted for by the participants.
3. Best dressed crew in the style of year of manufacture of the car.
4. Additional awards may be awarded at the discretion of the organisers.

**14. Insurance, Road Fund License & MOT:**

Owners of the entered vehicles will be asked to sign a declaration that their vehicle has a minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles, current and valid Road Fund Licence, and a valid MOT certificate for the duration of the event. Cars must comply with the MSA regulations for the event.

All crew members will also be required to sign a declaration at the start on the signing on sheet indemnifying the organisers and the Motor Sports Association from liability.

**15. Data Protection Act:**

Prospective entrants and competitors are advised that information supplied on the entry form will be held on a computer and used for the administration of the event.
