As this event is being held in the UK and run under a 'Touring Assembly Certificate of Exemption' issued by Motorsport UK, we are obliged to issue a set of **Supplementary Regulations** to give guidance to entrants on various aspects of the event

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The Grand Caledonian Tour is a unique event to be run between 25th September and 9th October 2021. The tour is designed that entrants may choose to do the whole tour of 15 days or 1, 2, 3 or however many they wish to do. The entire tour is 2015 miles long with 2 free days on Day 6 and Day 12. The route encompasses the whole periphery of the Scottish mainland with 2 diversions to islands of the Inner Hebrides. The complete route visits the extreme points of the compass on the Scottish mainland, Mull of Galloway, Ardnamurchan Point, Dunnet Head and Buchan Ness. The Start and Finish points and daily mileages are shown in the table below:

1. Announcement:

The Grand Caledonian Tour will take place between 25th September and 9th October 2021 and is organised by the CCHMSC Ltd. The event will start at Dobbies Garden Centre, Edinburgh EH18 1AZ (national grid reference NT314675) and finish at the Doubletree Hilton Hotel, North Queensferry, Fife KY11 1HP (NGR NT125806). Entrants may join and leave the tour at any point in which case the exact start and finish points will be given in the Final Instructions.

2. Jurisdiction:

The event will be held under the general rules of Motorsport UK as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. A Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption for a Touring Assembly has been applied for.

3. Eligibility:

The event is open to all members and non-members of the Caledonian Classic and Historic Motor Sport Club Ltd.

4. Vehicles:

The event is open to the following:

- Cars manufactured before 2000.
- Sporting cars of any age.
- Other cars permitted at the discretion of the organisers.

5. Entry List:

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form. The entry list closes on Saturday 18th September 2021.

6. Documentation:

Pre event document inspection and signing on will take place at Dobbies Garden Centre between 0900 and 0930 On 25th September and at any other convenient point throughout the tour

7. Scrutineering

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration to say that they have the following

- A valid MOT certificate (where applicable).
- Valid Road Tax
- A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

8 Route, Navigation and Driving Behaviour

The route will be on public A and B class and unclassified roads and will all be on sealed surfaces. Please note that some of the roads may be single-track and twisty where extra care will be required.

The route will be supplied prior to the start in paper or electronic format. It will take the form of marked maps in a road book with additional information on the route and points of interest.

One of the organisers will accompany the tour as 'Tour Leader' at all times to answer any relevant questions, give advice on the route etc. Their contact details are given in the road book.

Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Please remember other road users, cyclists, walkers and livestock.

9 Entries

EH26 9JL The entry fee is ZERO, however meals, accommodation and ferry fares are NOT included. It is the entrant's responsibility to book their own accommodation. The information pack supplied to all entrants gives a suggested list of accommodation. Entry includes a road book, rally plate and a finishers' award for which a small charge may be made. All entries must be made on the official entry form.

Entrants must indicate on the entry form if they wish to take part in the full tour or which part (days) they wish to take part in.
