

Tour of the Trossachs 7 September 2025

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The Tour of the Trossachs will start at Dobbies Garden Centre Stirling, Drip Road, Craigforth, Stirling FK9 4UF, finishing at Forrester Park Resort, Pitdinnie Rd, Cairneyhill, Dunfermline, KY12 8RF.

The route will explore some new roads across the region, covering approximately 120 miles of interesting and scenic roads, with a good mix of fast and twisting sections. There are a number of suggested lunch stop and points of Interest on the route, including the opportunity to enjoy a a 1 hour cruise on board Steamship Sir Walter Scott, or a 45-minute cruise aboard the Lady of the Lake, on Loch Katrine in the Loch Lomond and Trossachs National Park enjoying the dramatic Scottish Highlands scenery.

Tea, coffee and bacon rolls will be available to purchase at the start.

1. Announcement:

The Tour of the Trossachs will be held on Sunday 7 September 2025 and is organised by CCHMSC Ltd. The event will start at Dobbies Garden Centre Stirling, Drip Road, Craigforth, Stirling FK9 4UF, finishing at Forrester Park Resort, Pitdinnie Road, Cairneyhill, KY12 8RF

2. Jurisdiction:

The event will be held under the general rules of the Motorsport UK as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption 204249 has been issued.

3. Eligibility:

The event is open to all members of the Caledonian Classic and Historic Motor Sport Club Ltd, and members of the Saltire Rally Club, plus any other MSUK registered club. Membership of CCHMSC may be added to the entry form if required (£5 per person). Your MSUK club membership, must be valid for the date of this event.

4. Vehicles:

The event is open to the following:

- a) Cars manufactured before 1984.
- b) Sporting cars of any age.
- d) Other cars permitted at the discretion of the organisers.

5. Entry List:

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form.

The entry list closes on Friday 29 August 2025.

6. Documentation:

Pre event signing on will take place from 9.00 am at the above complex. The event will start at 10.00 am and you will be given your start time in the final instructions.

7. Scrutineering

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration to say that they have the following

- A valid MOT certificate, where applicable.
- A valid Road Fund Licence
- A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.
- Crews recommended to carry Safety vests, Warning triangle, and oil spillage / splash mat.

Cars must comply with the Motorsport UK regulations for the event.

8. Route, Navigation and Driving Behaviour:

The route will be on public A and B class and unclassified roads and will all be on sealed surfaces. The route instructions will be supplied along with the final instructions, before signing on, prior to the start. **Entrants should bring a road atlas of Scotland to transfer the route instructions on to create a marked up map.**

9. Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Please remember other road users, cyclists, walkers and livestock. NOTE 20mph speed limits through villages. Quiet roads are designated walking and cycling routes and have a 40 mph speed limit.

10. Entries:

Entry price is £65 per car. This includes a rally plate, route instructions and meal for two at the finish. Breakfast will be available at the start if required, at entrants own cost. All entries must be made on the entry form and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee & membership fee if applicable. Maximum number of entries is 40, minimum 15. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

12. Insurance:

Participants are responsible for ensuring that all drivers of vehicles entered in the event are fully covered by insurance during the event as required by the Road Traffic Acts and will be required to sign a declaration to that effect at the start. All crew members will also be required to sign a declaration at the start on the signing on sheet indemnifying the organisers and Motorsport UK from liability.

13. Data Protection Act:

Prospective entrants and competitors are advised that information supplied on the entry form will be held on a computer and used for the administration of the event.

14. Places of Interest = (POI) on route will be highlighted in the Route Instructions.

A stop at Loch Katrine will allow time to take an optional boat trip and refreshments. Two cruise options align with our tour timescale.
