The Ayrshire Bash

Sunday 23rd October 2016

The Veterans of Scottish Motorsport Association propose to hold an Autumn Run, called **The Ayrshire Bash**, on Sunday 23rd October 2016. The event will start from Gemmell's Garden Centre (Stair) and finish at Ballochmyle Golf Club and will cover approximately 50/70 miles. Food is available at both the start and finish locations.

1) <u>Announcement:</u>

The Ayrshire Bash will be held on Sunday 23rd October 2016 and is organised by the VSMA. The event will start from Gemmell's Garden Centre (Stair) and finish at Ballochmyle Golf Club. Signing on will take place at Gemmell's Garden Centre. The actual locations of the start & finish will be issued with the final instructions.

2) <u>Eligibility:</u>

The event is open to all car enthusiasts who are members of The VSMA and or members of the Caledonian Classic & Historic Motor Sport Club. Details of Club Membership may be inspected at documentation.

3) <u>Vehicles:</u>

The event is open to the following:

- a. Sporting cars of any age
- b. Other cars permitted at the discretion of the organisers.

4) Entry List:

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form.

The entry list closes on Saturday 8th October 2016.

Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.

5) <u>Documentation</u>:

Pre-event document inspection and signing on will take place from 10.00 at Gemmells's Garden Centre. The event will start at 11.45 from Gemmell's Garden Centre and as per the final Instructions.

6) <u>Signing on:</u>

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration to say that they have the following, where required by law

- a) A valid MOT certificate.
- b) A valid Road Fund Licence
- c) A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

7) <u>Route: Navigation and Driving Behaviour:</u>

The route is on OS Explorer sheet 327 - 1/25000. The route will be on public A and B class and unclassified roads. The route is approximately 50/70 miles and all will be on sealed surfaces. The route is <u>entirely smooth</u> with only one or two sections with very <u>slight</u> surface breaking. The route will be supplied after inspection of documentation and signing on, prior to the start. It will take the form of a Tulip Road book. Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Please remember other road users, cyclists, walkers and livestock.

Cars will start at one minute intervals – in an attempt to avoid"bunching". A variety of checks will be used throughout to ensure compliance with the route instructions.

8) <u>Entries:</u>

The entry fee for the event is £15.00 per car + food order for two people at the finish (see entry form).

This includes a tulip road book and a meal for two (if ordered) at the finish. The maximum number of entries is 40.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. No email entries will be accepted. All entries must be on the official entry form, with the appropriate fee enclosed as a cheque or postal order. Cheques to be made payable to:-The Veterans of Scottish Motorsport Association and submitted to:-
